Scripture of the Quarter

This scripture, tells how Joshua made it clear to all the people Moses had given him charge over how he felt about God.

*“And if it seems evil to you to serve the **Lord**, choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods (false gods) which your fathers served that were on the other side of the River, (Jordan River) or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you dwell. **But as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord.**” Joshua 24:15 NKJV*

Our goal is to preach the full Gospel of Jesus Christ and never compromise on God’s Holy Word. The ministry was founded in May of 2008, by Divine direction from God. In our prison ministry we go to the maximum security prisons for both men and women located in Gatesville, Texas.

Prisons for juveniles are called State schools in Texas; we currently go to Crockett and Gainesville, Texas. In prison ministry we follow the example in **Hebrews 13:3 Remember the prisoners as if chained with them—those who are mistreated—since you yourselves are in the body.**

The other goal of the ministry goes hand in hand with preaching the Gospel, and that is bringing this lost world to the knowledge of accepting Christ as their personal Savior. **John 3:16 “For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.”** We know with God all things are possible. In the world today there are so many lost souls who are hurting. Some are bound by all types of addictions. In **John 8:36 “So if the Son sets you free, you are truly free.”** This is comforting to know that Jesus can and will heal all addictions, but **YOU** must ask and then **BELIEVE** to receive.

Prophecy Corner 2010

The “Tribulation” is a seven year period divided into two halves of 1,260 days or 42 months in each half. Revelation Chapter 13 begins unfolding during the middle of this set time. During this point, a leader will lead a military invasion of Northeastern Africa, he will seize control of Egypt, Libya and Ethiopia (**Daniel 11:42-43**). He will march an Islamic Army into Israel dividing Jerusalem into East and West taking possession of the Temple Mount in Jerusalem where he will be considered a hero (**Revelation 11:1-2**). This man is what the Bible calls the “Antichrist” identified in Daniel as the



little horn with a mouth speaking great things (**Daniel 7:8**). This man will control ten future kings and their kingdoms. Which are the ten toes of the statue (**Daniel 2:41-43**).

The “Temple Mount” currently has two Islamic mosques they called the “Dome of the Rock” and “Al Aqsa.” They sit on the 27 acres of flat property on the mountain in the city of Jerusalem. At the present time there is no Jewish Temple on the “Temple Mount.” Since Jesus said that Elijah would come and restore all things (**Matthew 17:11**), then perhaps the actual rebuilding of a future Jewish temple is linked to the appearance and ministry of the famous two witnesses of Revelation 11. The Gentiles would trample Jerusalem for 42 months, the two witnesses appear during the first half of the Tribulation (**Malachi 4:5-6**). This rebuilding will transpire during the first 42 months and the actual Temple dedication will be interrupted by an invasion of the antichrist who kills the two witnesses (**Revelations 11:7**) thus becoming a hero among the Muslims as he takes

complete control of the sacred mountain. The enemies of Israel rejoice (**Revelation 11:10**). Once the antichrist seizes total control of East Jerusalem and the Temple Mount the False Prophet will join him and multitudes will worship the man as though he were god.

(**2 Thessalonians 2:3-4**) At this point the false prophet will construct the icon (statue or image) of the beast (the antichrist). On competition the false prophet causes the image to speak. At this time the mark of the “beast” will be required of everyone – small, great, rich, and poor, free or slave – to be given a mark on the right hand or on the forehead. Then no one will be allowed to buy or sell anything without that mark, which was either the name of the beast or the number representing his name. Commonly known as 666. (**Revelation 13:11-18**)

JOSHUA

His name means "Yahweh Is Salvation"

His Work: He was Moses' aide and successor, a military commander and statesman.

His Character: His remarkable military successes were achieved as a result of his attitude of trust and obedience toward the God who made them all possible.

His Sorrow: That the Israelites failed to believe his good report of the Promise Land and that he and they were consequently prevented from entering it for forty years.

His Triumph: To have led the Israelites to victory in Canaan, thus establishing them in the land God had promised their forefathers Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

His Story

When God calls someone to play a part in the history of his people, he often begins by testing his or her faith. Joshua's first test was to return a faithful report after he had spied out the land of Canaan with its Giants and strong cities. Later God told him to cross the Jordan despite the fact that the river was at flood stage.

But the challenges did not stop. To enter Canaan, the Israelites would have to take the city of Jericho, which lay five miles west of the Jordan River. But there was one little problem. High-walled, well-fortified cities had discouraged Israel's spies forty years earlier, and Joshua knew that their desert wanderings had not rendered the former slaves any more physically capable of laying siege to the city then they had been.

But Joshua believed that God had already delivered Jericho into their hands. They had merely to march around it for six days. On the seventh day, seven priests carrying trumpets of rams' horns would lead the army seven more times around the city. When the priests blew the last blast of the trumpet, all the people were to shout at the top of their lungs and the walls of

the city would simply collapse. To practical-minded people—to most of us—this would have seemed a ridiculous plan. But it was the strategy Joshua employed, bringing about a victory that terrorized the other peoples of Canaan, thus paving the way for Israel's future military success.

As each test grew larger, Joshua's faith kept pace, his obedience nourishing his faith and his faith nourishing his obedience. The man who had witnessed Israel's deliverance from Egypt, who had walked across the Red Sea, and who had stayed alive eating manna in the desert was not about to doubt God's power to do what he said he would. Because of Joshua's faithfulness, the Israelites experienced victory after victory as they swept across the land and made it their own.
